The Gospel Project for Kids

The following is to be used as a resource during I. READ THE BIBLE (5 MINUTES)

We are beginning in YEAR 1 with Volume 1: In The Beginning. Each Volume is made up of 3 units with individual weekly sessions.

Each unit will have 1 <u>Key Passage</u> the kids will be challenged to memorize and you as parents are challenged to learn it right along with them. This Key Passage is repeated each week/session for the entire unit.

Each unit will have 1 <u>Big Picture Question</u>. Kids and Preschoolers can learn important doctrines of the Christian faith. Each *Big Picture Question* helps them systematically learn these theological concepts. Memorizing these Big Picture Questions are "as valuable for learning the Bible as memorizing multiplication tables for learning mathematics."¹

<u>Parent Resources</u>. As parents rise to their calling to be the primary disciplers of their kids, our role as the church is to equip, support and develop them to do so. We do this by connecting both before and after each week's session so parents know what their children are being taught as well as how they can keep gospel conversations going throughout the week.
